Cookie Policy

This Cookie policy explains what cookies are and how we use them. You should read this policy so you can understand what type of cookies we use, the information we collect using cookies and how that information is used.

What are Cookies?

Cookies are small data-files that websites and web-applications store on your device. They are processed and stored by your web browser, and are in themselves harmless but often serve crucial functions for websites.

There are generally 4 types of Cookies.

Session cookies

These cookies are used to store temporary information. The information is acquired through a single session or the time between the opening and closing of your browser. Once you close your browser, they are automatically deleted.

Persistent Cookies

Permanent cookies are not deleted once you close your browser but they are stored on your device until the expiration date or until you delete them manually.

First-party Cookies

The term "first party" means getting cookies directly from the website's domain you are on.

Third-party Cookies

These cookies are related to external domains as they are not issued by the website's domain you are on.

Types of cookies we use

At Dispo we only use Cookies for the purposes set out below:

Type: Session Cookies

Purpose: These Cookies are essential to provide you with the Dispo platform and all of its features. The cookies help to authenticate you and prevent fraudulent use of your user account. Without these Cookies, the Dispo platform cannot function properly.

List of cookies

Name	Function
__RequestVerificationToken	<p>This is an anti-forgery cookie set by web applications built using ASP.NET MVC technologies. It is designed to stop unauthorised posting of content to a website, known as Cross-Site Request Forgery. It holds no information about the user and is destroyed on closing the browser.</p> <p>The main purpose of this cookie is: Strictly Necessary</p>
.ASPXAUTH	<p>This cookie is used by sites using the .NET technology platform from Microsoft. It is commonly used to identify a logged-in user to enable access to secure areas of a site.</p> <p>The main purpose of this cookie is: Strictly Necessary</p>
ASP.NET_SessionId	<p>General purpose platform session cookie, used by sites written with Microsoft .NET based technologies. Usually used to maintain an anonymised user session by the server.</p> <p>The main purpose of this cookie is: Strictly Necessary</p>

Why do we only use so few cookies

At Dispo we believe in privacy and therefore we have built Dispo to use only the minimum required system cookies.

We are not storing personal accessible information in cookies.

How do I delete and/or block cookies?
